The Minutes of the last meeting, having been circulated, were proposed by Clr. R.M. Vaughan, seconded by Clr H.G. Jones, were signed by the Chairman.

MATTERS ARISING

Road Sweeping Clr. G.M. Jones informed Councillors that Powys County Council have only one road sweeper covering Montgomeryshire and Radnorshire and he did not know when it would be back in this area. Clr. D.E. Chapman asked that the road from Morfodion to Oakley Park be swept. Clr. Jones would report this.

Lack of Passing Places on A.470 This Council has been asked to contact Russell George's office in Cardiff and speak to his office manager on this issue as he preparing a statement on the lack of passing places on the A.470. The clerk was asked to contact Clr. A.K. Davies who has been very proactive on this matter. Clr. Davies has compiled a list of coordinated of existing partly suitable laybys from Llangurig to Welshpool and this is available to Councillors. It was also proposed that the clerk write to Edwina Hart asking for a site meeting with Officials to discuss matters.

BDO Audit Mrs Janet Crisp had agreed to audit the accounts for this year and was in the process of doing so.

Paddy's Castle Clr. G.M. Jones informed Councillors that he believed that the blocked drains were on private ground on Mr Coate's side but he would look into this matter further.

PLANNING APPLICATIONS

P2015 0319 Removal of existing corrugated sheds and erection of stores building at Van Village Institute, Van Llanidloes, Powys.

It was proposed by Clr. D.W. Morgan, seconded by Clr. S.E. Evans that this application be supported and it was unanimously agreed.

P2015 0357 Siting of 3 no. holiday log cabins (including demolition of existing farm buildings) installation of a package treatment plant and associated ground works at Clydfannau, Dolwen, Llanidloes.

It was proposed by Clr. R.M.Vaughan, seconded by Clr. G. Jones; that this application be supported and it was unanimously agreed.

One Voice Wales - June Trainings The clerk has received details of training sessions that are taking place in or around our area and these are available to Councillors.

One Voice Wales – Montgomeryshire Area Committee The Annual meeting of the Montgomeryshire Area Committee will be held on 7pm on Wednesday 10th June 2015 at the Community Centre, Castle Caereinion. The Clerk to inform One Voice Wales of the change of Chairman and Vice Chairman.

Wales Audit Office The Wales Audit Office, the Older People's Commissioner and Good Practice Wales are holding a free seminar on the Continued Independence of Old People on Wednesday 1st July at the Swalec Stadium, Cardiff CF11 9XR. Wales has a population with the highest proportion of older people in the UK. Nearly one in five (19%) of the population of Wales is aged 65 and over. The number is projected to increase by 50 per cent between 2012 and 2037.

Concert Clr. A.K. Davies has prepared breakdown of the cost of the Concert in November complete with Artists names, telephone numbers and e-mail addresses and this is available from the clerk. Clr. Davies was thanked for the work he had put in and the price of the tickets would be decided at the June meeting.

Newtown Bypass Clr D.E. Chapman asked for an update on the Newtown Bypass which he felt was badly needed. Clr. G.M. Jones informed Councillors that there was a possibility of a Public Inquiry as some objections had been received and negotiations were still to be undertaken. Some farms on route were to be cut in half and they had been received advice from Farmers in the Newbridge area who had been through a similar process.

The Day Centre, Llanidloes Councillors are invited to take part in a meeting at Llanidloes Church Hall at 7pm on Thursday June 11th to meet with senior figures from Powys County Council who are engaged in reviewing the day centre provision in the County, with a view to making saving.
