The Minutes of the last meeting, having been circulated, were proposed by Clr. R.M. Vaughan, seconded by Clr. H.G. Jones, and agreed as correct, were signed by the Chairman.

MATTERS ARISING

Questions from Members of the Public - None.

Brynposteg Landfill Site The Brynposteg Landfill Residents Liaison Meeting scheduled to take place on 8th June, 2016 was cancelled. Natural Resources Wales will be working with Powys County Council to reschedule the meeting and re-arrange the meeting as soon as possible and they will notify us of the new date. The clerk was asked to write to Aled Zachary, Natural Resources Wales and impress on him the importance of holding the meeting as soon as possible and Clr. G.Jones stated that all interested parties need to be invited.

Fan Lead Mines Nothing further had been received on this matter.

Planning Applications Paper Copies Clr. G.M. Jones had received an e-mail that no more paper copies would be sent out to Community Councils in the future. After speaking to the Portfolio Holder it was agreed to supply the community council for the next six months. There had been grant funding available which has now been withdrawn, but the Clerk had not been aware of this grant funding, which seems to be common for all clerks. It was agreed that the Clerk and Councillors would see if there were grants available from other organisations to buy a new laptop, printer or projector for future use.

Upper Bridge Enterprises Clr Gareth Owen had checked the new website proposed by Upper Bridge Enterprises and Councillors agreed to go ahead with this matter.

Llidiartywaen Road Clr. A.K. Davies had e-mailed Adrian Jervis with a list of improvements discussed at a site meeting previously regarding the provision of a few passing places on the Llidiartywaen Road. He asked Clr. G.M. Jones if it was correct that not all proposed improvements would be considered. Clr. G.M. Jones would look into this matter.

Community Council Accounts 2015/16 Mrs Janet Crisp had audited the accounts and found them to be correct.

Vehicles parked on the side of Bryndu road Councillors were very concerned at the amount of vehicles parked on the side of the Bryndu road from the bridge up to Eric Jerman's yard. This evening there was a large lorry parked on the side of the road which had made the road very

dangerous to travel down. The clerk was asked to bring this matter again to the attention of the appropriate authorities.

Recycling in Llanidloes No new site had been found to date, but it had been confirmed that it would not be moved to the Gro Car Park as it was unsuitable.

One Voice Wales The Montgomeryshire Area Committee was held at 7.00pm on Wednesday, 8th June, 2016 at the Community Centre, Llanbryn-mair. No Councillors had been able to attend.

Donation request for Defibrillator at Y Fan Clr.G.M. Jones had been asked if the Community Council would be willing to contribute towards the provision of a defibrillator at Y Fan. Councillors agreed to consider this when a written donation request was received by the clerk.

Baptist Chapel Councillors unanimously agreed a donation to the Zion Baptist Chapel for its use of the Schoolroom for six meetings from January to December of £108.00. The clerk was instructed to pay.

Grasscutting Councillor H.G. Jones informed the meeting that grass cutting had not been done and the verges were very overgrown, Clr G. Jones said that the grass was 5-6 foot high encroaching onto the road, and both asked when work would begin. Clr. G.M. Jones informed Councillors that the Contractor who had won the contract had withdrawn and this work had gone out to tender again. A new contractor would be appointed.

Bench on Gorn Road Clr. R.M. Vaughan reported that a new wooden bench had replaced the old bench on the Gorn road, by a local person in memory of her husband. Llanidloes Town Council had given permission for the bench to be replaced.

Oakley Park Clr. G. Jones informed Councillors that six rubbish bins are placed on the junction of Wigdwr Lane and Pentre Lane in Oakley Park, when they are emptied that are filled with rubbish immediately. People are bringing their rubbish there, dirty nappies etc which is very unhygienic. Vermin/dogs will tip them over and the rubbish is left on the floor, Council workmen do not pick up any of this rubbish. The clerk was asked to report this matter to the Portfolio Holder John Powell.
