

MINUTES of a Meeting of LLANIDLOES WITHOUT COMMUNITY COUNCIL

The Minutes of the last meeting, having been circulated, were approved by Councillors and were signed by the Chairman.

MATTERS ARISING

Conditions of roads in the area Clr. G.M. Jones was concerned that work is outstanding on the road to Old Hall which had been promised to be done this summer. Clr. G. Jerman reported that gutters needed to be opened on the B4518 Llanidloes to Bwlchygle road. Roads are deteriorating fast as water is standing and not being able to run off into the gutters. The clerk was asked to pass on the Council's concerns to County Councillors.

Bottom Roundabout into Llanidloes The clerk has had no response to her email to Powys County Council.

Llanidloes Hospital The clerk had received no responses to her emails.

Audit Wales The clerk had received a revised bill for 2021/22 Audit fees from Audit Wales of £817.00 and Councillors agreed to pay. The original fee had been £1200.00.

Provision of toilets around Clywedog Dam No response has been received by the clerk.

Dyfed Powys Neighbourhood Watch Dyfed Powys Police are asking for support in promoting Dyfed-Powys Police Neighbourhood Watch initiative and details of this scheme were circulated to Councillors.

Llanidloes Futures Llanidloes Futures, a charity group promoting solar panels in the local community are keen to learn more about the new solar array at the Potters site. Councillors are aware that a planning application has been submitted and believe that it has been granted but no other information had been received.

One Voice Wales One Voice Wales has launched a consultation on the role, governance and accountability of the community and town council sector, and will hold an inquiry on 1 October 2024 between 1.30 and 4pm. The Senedd will also be running a virtual consultation event on 23 October, 2024. Details of this will be circulated once the event is confirmed.

One Voice Wales Montgomery Area Committee The next meeting will take place at 7.30pm on Thursday 10TH October 2024. This will be an online meeting using Zoom and the link is available from the clerk.

Free Resources to help fly tipping in our Community Fly-tipping Action Wales are providing free printable posters, leaflets and signs for all organisations affected by fly-tipping. This campaign is created in partnership with Welsh Government. Details are available from the clerk.
