The Minutes of the last meeting, having been circulated, were approved by Councillors and were signed by the Chairman.

MATTERS ARISING

Conditions of roads in area Councillors bought up the poor state of the roads in our area, with gutters and drains needing to be cleaned, with water being left standing on the roads. Clr. G. Preston has had a meeting with Highway Officers who have informed him that surface dressing on the road from Westgate Street to Cerist would be done and Felindre to Blue Bell, Llangurig was included in next years Capital works. The B4518 has a lot of water standing on the road and this is a primary gritting road. Councillors also asked when salt heaps would be put out as there are none at the present time and we have had some frosty weather.

An oak tree on the B4518 just by the 1st entrance passed caravan park which has been dead for years and needs to be removed.

Another culvert is blocked just passed the pet cemetery and water is across the road all the day.

No work has been done to the Old Hall road. Clr. Preston will look into these matters.

Railings at Felindre Clr. G.M. Jones reported that these railings need to be done urgently.

Defibrillator The clerk is waiting for prices on the defibrillator boxes.
